 - 2. Let loose The best photos capture natural laughter and expressions. Instead of your typical pose, try snapping a pic after telling your go-to joke.





Location: North Reflection Pond

See the Gateway Arch emerge from the treetops as the perfect backdrop for your photos.

Pro tip! Angle your camera to capture reflections across the water.

Location: Visitor's Center

Capture that feeling of seeing the Arch up close for the very first time as you approach the Visitor's Center

Make it wide! Get low and zoom out to include the Arch in your shot.







Pave Your Own Photography Path

The best part of any photoshoot is the unexpected gems you find along the way, and Gateway Arch National Park has no shortage of hidden treasures.

Make your photos stand out by perusing the park with your unique eye. As you continue exploring, you'll find even more stunning backdrops, from secluded tree coves to scenic walkways that frame the Arch in distinct ways. Don't be afraid to wander and discover your own favorite angles-there's always another picture-perfect spot waiting to be captured in and around the park!

Location: Grand Staircase

Find the perfect low-angle shot to showcase the grandeur of North America's tallest monument.

Get creative! Position your subjects on different stair levels to add dimension.

Location: South Reflection Pond

Emphasize the natural beauty of Gateway Arch National Park at the southernmost corner of the reflection pond.

Fun fact! Geese, ducks, and other park critters love to photobomb in this spot.

Location: South Overlook

Display the river, park, and city skyline that defines everyone's introduction to St. Louis

Add to your shot! Structures like the Ead's Bridge can greatly elevate the quality of your backdrop.
